PECANS

CHOCTAW - Protogonous, Large nut, thin shell, vigorous, productive, very disease resistant.
DESIRABLE - Protandrous, Large nut, medium shell, good resistance, dependable bearer.
KANZA - Protogonous, Medium nut, soft shell, strong vigorous tree, good disease resistance.
KIOWA - Protogonous, Large nut, medium shell, productive, good resistance, excellent quality.
LAKOTA - Protogonous, Large nut, soft shell, very productive tree, good disease resistance.
OCONEE - Protandrous, Large nut, thin shell, good disease resistance, larger shade tree.
PAWNEE - Protandrous, Medium to large nut, thin shell, ripens early, high kernel percentage.

ALMONDS

ALL IN ONE - S.F., 500 Hours, Medium to large soft shell, heavy producer. Ripens late Sept.

WALNUTS

PEDRO - S.F., Medium nut with excellent flavor. Much shorter tree than other walnuts. Ripens mid Sept.
PLACENTIA - S.F., Medium nut, light tan meat fills the shell well. Ripens mid Sept.

POMEGRANATES

AFGANSKI - S.F., Large red fruit with red juice and hard seeds, sweet with a slightly tart flavor, very cold hardy. Ripens in Sept. - Oct.
AL SIRIN NAR - S.F., Large red fruit with red juice and hard seeds, sweet and tart flavor, heavy producer and high juice quality. Ripens in Oct.
AMBROSIA - S.F., Large pink fruit with purple juice and soft seeds, sweet and tart flavor, produces the largest sized fruit. Ripens in Sept. - Oct.
EVERSWEET - S.F., Medium pink fruit with clear juice and soft seeds, sweet flavor, non-staining juice. Ripens in Sept. - Oct.
KARA BALA MIURSAL - S.F., Medium red fruit with dark red juice and hard seeds, sweet and tart flavor, high juice content. Ripens in Sept. - Oct.
KASHMIR BLEND - S.F., Medium pink fruit with red juice and hard seeds, sweet flavor, semi-dwarf. Ripens in Oct. - Nov.
PARFIANKA - S.F., Large red fruit with bright red juice and soft seeds, sweet and tart flavor, high quality fruit. Ripens in Sept. - Oct.
PINK SATIN - S.F., Medium pink fruit with light pink juice and soft seeds, sweet flavor, non-staining juice. Ripens in Oct.
SALAVATSKI - S.F., Large red fruit with red juice and hard seeds, sweet and tart flavor, very cold hardy. Ripens in Oct.
SIRENEVYI - S.F., Large yellowish-pink fruit with red spots, dark red juice and soft seeds, sweet - tart flavor, very cold hardy. Ripens in Sept. - Oct.
SURH-ANOR (Pecos) - S.F., Large yellowish-pink fruit with clear juice and soft seeds, sweet flavor, non-staining juice. Ripens in Oct.
SWEET - S.F., Medium pink fruit with pink juice and soft seeds, sweet flavor, non-staining juice. Ripens in Sept.
WONDERFUL - S.F., Large red fruit with red juice and soft seeds, sweet and tart flavor, heavy producer. Ripens in Sept.

PERSIMMONS

CHOCOLATE - S.F., Small to medium orange fruit. Non-astringent. Excellent pollinator. Ripens Oct. - Nov.
FUYU - S.F., Large, round, flattened fruit with a reddish skin, sweet flavor. Non-astringent. Ripens in Nov.
HACHIYA - S.F., Large, heart shaped sweet fruit with a bright orange-red skin, astringent until fully ripe. Ripens in Nov.
TAMOPAN - S.F., Large, flat fruit with a ridge on it, sweet golden-orange skin, astringent until fully ripe. Ripens in Nov.

FIGS

ALMA - S.F., Small to medium fruit, golden-brown skin, amber flesh, sweet flavor, heavy producer. Closed eye.
BLACK MISSION - S.F., Medium to large pear shaped fruit, black-purplish skin, red flesh, delicious fresh or dried. Open eye.
BLACKJACK - S.F., Large purplish fruit, strawberry red flesh, semi-dwarf bush, sweet and juicy flavor. Open eye.
BLUE GIANT - S.F., Extra large fruit, dark purple skin, sweet reddish-amber flesh, produces all summer. Semi-closed eye.
BROWN TURKEY - S.F., Medium to large bell shaped fruit, brownish-purple skin, reddish-amber flesh. Open eye.
CELESTE (Celestial) - S.F., Small to medium fruit, brownish-purple skin, reddish light amber flesh, juicy sweet taste, excellent quality. Closed eye.
CHICAGO HARDY - S.F., Small to medium fruit, light brownish-violet skin, pink flesh, excellent flavor, cold hardy. Closed eye.
EXCEL - S.F., Medium fruit, yellow skin, sweet amber flesh with rich flavor. Semi-closed eye.
GE NERI - S.F., Extra large almost tennis ball size fruit, purple skin, reddish-amber flesh, sweet flavor. Semi-closed eye.
GREEN ITSHCIA - S.F., Small fruit, green skin, strawberry-red flesh, bird resistant. Closed eye.
KADOTA - S.F., Large fruit, light greenish-yellow skin, amber flesh, very sweet flavor. Semi-closed eye.
L.S.U. PURPLE - S.F., Medium fruit, dark purple skin, sweet strawberry-red flesh, heavy producer. Closed eye.
LATTARULA - S.F., Medium fruit, greenish-yellow skin, amber flesh, semi-dwarf tree. Semi-closed eye.
LEMON - S.F., Medium to large fruit, yellowish to green skin, white to amber flesh, very sweet lemon flavor. Semi-closed eye.
LITTLE MISS FIGGY - S.F., Small to medium fruit, purple skin, red flesh, dwarf tree, sweet and juicy flavor. Open eye.
LITTLE RUBY - S.F., Small fruit, red skin, strawberry-red flesh, dwarf tree suitable for pots or bonsai, sweet flavor. Semi-closed eye.
MAGNOLIA - S.F., Large fruit, bronze skin, amber flesh, good fresh or for drying. Open eye.
OLYMPIAN - S.F., Large fruit, purple skin, reddish-violet flesh, very sweet flavor, cold hardy. Semi-closed eye.
OSBORNE PROLIFIC - S.F., Large fruit, purplish-brown skin, amber flesh, pleasing flavor, heavy bearer. Open eye.
PANACHE TIGER - S.F., Small to medium fruit, yellow skin with green stripes, red flesh, sweet flavor. Open eye.
PETER'S HONEY - S.F., Small to medium fruit, yellow skin, amber flesh, very sweet flavor, cold tolerant. Closed eye.
TEXAS EVERBEARING - S.F., Medium fruit, brownish-yellow skin, amber flesh, cold tolerant. Closed eye.
VIOLETTE DE BORDEAUX - S.F., Small to medium fruit, purple skin, deep red flesh, sweet flavor, semi-dwarf tree. Semi-closed eye.

NECTARINES

ATOMIC RED WHITE - S.F., 500 Hours, Semi-freestone, medium white flesh sweet fruit, beautiful red double flowers. Ripens in mid June.
DESERT DELIGHT - S.F., 150 Hours, Semi-freestone, large yellow fleshed flavorful fruit, bright red skin. Ripens mid June.
DOUBLE DELIGHT - S.F., 300 Hours, Semi-freestone, excellent medium yellow fleshed fruit, dark red skin. Heavy bearer. Ripens in July.
FANTASIA - S.F., 500 Hours, Freestone, large bright red with yellow fruit, tangy sweet rich flavor. Ripens mid July.
PANAMINT - S.F., 300 Hours, Freestone, large red skin fruit with golden flesh. Ripens early July.
SUNLITE - S.F., 450 Hours, Freestone, large bright red with yellow fruit, good quality flavor. Ripens early July.
SUNRAYCER - S.F., 300 Hours, Semi-freestone, large red blushed fruit with firm yellow flesh. Ripens mid May

NECTAPLUM (Nectarine x plum cross)

SPICE ZEE NECTAPLUM - S.F., 300 Hours, Semi-freestone, white fleshed fruit with nectarine x plum flavors, dark skin fruit turns pale pink when ripe. Purplish-pink blooms followed by red leaves in spring turning green in summer. Very productive. Ripens in late July.

PLUMS

BEAUTY - S.F., 250 Hours, Medium fruit with red over yellow skin, sweet amber flesh. Ripens mid June.
BURGUNDY - S.F., 350 Hours, Medium fruit with dark cherry red skin and deep red flesh. Ripens mid June.
CATALINA - S.F., 350 Hours, Large black sweet & juicy fruit, firm amber flesh, heavy producer. Ripens in late July.
GREEN GAGE - S.F., 350 Hours, Medium greenish-yellow skin fruit, very sweet and juicy, heavy fruit set, Ripens in July.
METHLEY - S.F., 250 Hours, Large reddish-purple skin fruit with a sweet amber colored flesh. Ripens in July.
SANTA ROSA - S.F., 400 Hours, Large oval, plum colored fruit with a sweet, tart yellow flesh. Ripens in June.

LI - S.F., Large two inches in diameter fruit, almost round shape, small pit and deliciously sweet and crisp. Ripens mid Sept.
SHANXI LI - S.F., Extra large over two inches in diameter fruit, almost round shape, small pit, sweet apple flavor. Ripens late Sept.
SUGAR CANE - S.F., Medium, extremely sweet elongated fruit, thorny stems but worth it. Ripens Sept.

PEACHES

GROUP A: San Antonio and to the east & south from to Pearsall, Three Rivers, Victoria, La Grange, Bastrop and similar regions

DESERT GOLD - S.F., 350 Hours, Semi-freestone, medium yellow skin fruit with red blush, sets heavy. Ripens early May.
EARLIGRANDE - S.F., 225 Hours, Freestone, medium to large, juicy yellow-red skin fruit. Excellent flavor. Ripens late April.
FLORDAPRINCE - S.F., 150 Hours, Semi-freestone, medium red skin, very sweet flavor. Ripens mid May.
RED BARON - S.F., 200 Hours, Freestone, medium yellow skin fruit with red flesh, firm juicy flavor. Ripens mid July.
SANTA BARBARA - S.F., 300 Hours, Freestone, large yellow flesh fruit, very sweet, excellent flavor. Ripens mid July.
TROPIC SNOW - S.F., 200 Hours, Freestone, medium white skin fruit with red blush, sweet white flesh. Ripens early May.

GROUP B: San Antonio and the surrounding areas out to Boerne, Hondo, Devine, Floresville, Sequin, and similar regions

BABCOCK - S.F., 450 Hours, Freestone, large peach with a sweet white flesh. Ripens mid July.
FLORDAKING - S.F., 450 Hours, Cling, large yellow flesh fruit with good flavor. Ripens late May.
GALAXY - S.F., 450 Hours, Freestone, large donut shaped fruit, white flesh, very sweet flavor. Ripens late June.
JOHN FANICK - S.F., 500 Hours, Freestone, medium to large fruit with yellow flesh, excellent flavor. Ripens mid July.
JUNE GOLD - S.F., 450 Hours, Semi-freestone, large juicy yellow fruit, heavy producer. Ripens in June.
LA FELICIANA - S.F., 450 Hours, Freestone, large yellow fruit with excellent flavor. Ripens mid July.
LA FESTIVAL - S.F., 450 Hours, Freestone, medium to large yellow fruit, great flavor. Ripens mid June.
RIO GRANDE - S.F., 425 Hours, Freestone, medium yellow skin fruit with yellow flesh. Good shipper. Ripens early June.
SAM HOUSTON - S.F., 550 Hours, Freestone, medium yellow fruit with a great flavor. Ripens mid June.
SWEET BAGEL - S.F., 400 Hours, Freestone, large yellow donut shaped fruit. Ripens early July.
4-N-1 MODERATE PEACH - S.F., 350-600, Four peaches on one tree for better production & variety. Suited for medium chill areas.

GROUP C: North & west of San Antonio from Uvalde, Junction, Comfort, Fredericksburg and further northern regions

EARLY ELBERTA - S.F., 750 Hours, Freestone, large yellow-red blush skin fruit with yellow flesh. Ripens early July.
HALEHAVEN - S.F., 850 Hours, Freestone, large firm fruit with yellow flesh, great for the hill country area. Ripens in July.
LORING - S.F., 800 Hours, freestone, large fruit, yellow skin with red blush, good quality. Ripens early July.
REDSKIN - S.F., 750 Hours, Freestone, large yellow flesh fruit with deep red skin, excellent flavor. Ripens in Aug.

DWARF PEACHES

BONANZA - S.F., 250 Hours, Freestone, large red-blushed fruit with a juice yellow flesh. Ripens mid June.
BONFIRE - S.F., 250 Hours, Cling, attractive purple foliage, white & red striped fleshed fruit, great for canning. Ripens late Sept.
ELDORADO - S.F., 400 Hours, Freestone, medium red-blushed skin, yellow richly flavored flesh. Ripens mid June.
PIX-ZEE - S.F., 400 Hours, Freestone, large delicious fruit on a compact tree. Ripens late June.

APRICOTS

BLLENHEIM - S.F., 450 Hours, Medium to large, juicy, good for canning or drying. Ripens late June - July.
TROPIC GOLD - S.F., 350 Hours, Medium to large excellent juicy fruit, good fresh or for canning or drying. Ripens late June - July.

PEACHCOT

PEACHCOT - S.F., 300 - 600 Hours, Freestone, small, dark orange fruit with a peach - apricot taste. Ripens in August.

APPLES

ANNA - N.F., 200 Hours, Medium, light green skin fruit with red blush, crisp and sweet flavor. Ripens mid July.
BRAEBURN - S.F., 500 Hours, Medium to large green skin fruit, tart juicy flavor, crisp texture. Ripens late Oct.
DORSETT GOLDEN - S.F., 100 Hours, Medium yellow fruit, firm and sweet. Ripens mid July.
EIN SHEMER - S.F., 350 Hours, Large yellow fruit with a crisp tart taste. Ripens late June.
GALA - S.F., 500 Hours, Medium yellow fruit with a red blush, crisp juicy sweet flavor. Ripens mid Sept.
GRANNY SMITH - S.F., 400 Hours, Medium, bright green fruit with a tart flavor, good for eating and cooking. Ripens late Aug.
RED FUJI - S.F., 350 - 400 Hours, Medium red blush fruit covering entire surface, firm and crunchy, sweet flavor. Ripens mid Sept.
YELLOW DELICIOUS - S.F., 600 Hours, Large golden yellow skin fruit, crisp firm texture. Ripens late Sept.
4-N-1 MILD OR MODERATE APPLE - S.F., Mild 100 to 500 hours / Moderate 350 to 600 hours. Four grafted apples on one tree.

CRAB APPLE

TRANSCENDENT - S.F., 400 hours, Large 2 inch yellow fruit with a red cheek, good for eating and cooking. Ripens mid Aug.

PEARS

FAN-STIL - S.F., Medium size soft pear, great fresh off the tree, high quality flavor. Fireblight resistant. Ripens in Aug.
KIEFFER - S.F., Large firm canning pear with great flavor, stores well. Some fireblight resistant. Ripens in Sept. - Oct.
MONTERREY - S.F., Large round apple shaped fruit. Excellent sweet flavor. Fireblight resistant. Ripens in Aug. - Sept.
ORIENT - N.F., Large soft pear, used fresh or for canning. Some fireblight resistant. Ripens in Aug.
WARREN - S.F., Medium long necked fruit, very sweet and juicy, smooth flesh. Fireblight resistant. Ripens in Aug.

ASIAN APPLE PEARS

HOSUI - S.F., Medium to large fruit with a golden skin, sweet and juicy, good keeper. Ripens late Aug. - Sept.
SHINKO - N.F., Medium to large fruit with a russeted skin, juicy sweet flavor, excellent quality. Ripens late Aug. - Sept.
SHINSEIKI - S.F., Medium size sweet fruit, juicy crisp flavor, heavy bearer, pollinates other pears. Ripens mid Aug.
TWENTIETH CENTURY - S.F., Medium size fruit, crisp and juicy flavor, heavy bearer. Ripens mid Aug.
4-N-1 ASIAN PEAR - S.F., Four different asian pears on one tree for more fruit production and variety. Good for small yards.

SWEET CHERRIES

MINI ROYAL - N.F., 500 Hours, Medium red fruit with good flavor, pollinated by Royal Lee. Ripens in June.
ROYAL CRIMSON (6GM25) - S.F., 300-400+/- Hours, Medium bright crimson red fruit with superb flavor. Ripens in June.
ROYAL LEE - N.F., 500 Hours, Medium red heart shaped fruit, excellent flavor, pollinated by Mini Royal. Ripens in June.

4-N-1 and 5-N-1 FRUIT SALAD TREES

FRUIT SALAD TREE - S.F., 400 - 600 Hours, Four to five different fruits on one tree. Grafts: peach, plum, nectarine, and apricot.

MULBERRIES

DWARF EVERBEARING - S.F., Medium purple fruit on a compact tree, grows up to 10ft - 12ft+. Ripens in May - July.
ILLINOIS - S.F., Large sweet fruit on a cold hardy tree. Ripens June - September.
NATIVE - S.F., Medium purple to reddish fruit, fast growing tree. Ripens in May - July.
PURPLE PAKISTAN - S.F., Extra large purple fruit up to five inches long, fast growing tree. Ripens in May - July.
TEAS - S.F., Weeping growth habit, small reddish-purple fruit, sweet flavor, mature height only 10 ft. Ripens in May - June
WHITE PAKISTAN - S.F., Extra large white fruit up to five inches long, fast growing tree. Ripens in May - July.

GRAPES

BLACK MONUKKA - S.F., (Seedless) Large purplish - black fruit, sweet flavor, crisp berries. Ripens in Aug. - Sept.
BLACK SPANISH (R) - S.F., (Seeds) Small black fruit, great for wine, jelly, and juice. Ripens in Aug. - Sept.
BLANC DU BOIS (R) - S.F., (Seeds) Medium green fruit, excellent for wine making, heavy bearer, loose cluster. Ripens in July - Aug.
CHAMPANEL (R) - S.F., (Seeds) Large black fruit, general purpose grape for eating, wine, juice, or jelly. Ripens early July.
FLAME - S.F., (Seedless) Medium, red skin, very productive and sweet flavor, strong grower, good table grape. Ripens in July.
HIMROD - S.F., (Seedless) Medium white table grape with good flavor, strong grower. Ripens Aug. - Sept.
SOUTHERN JEWEL (R) - S.F., (Seeds) Small black fruit with excellent flavor. Heavy producer. Great table grape. Ripens early Aug.
SOUTHERN SENSATION (R) - S.F., (Seedless) Medium white table grape, thin skin, crisp texture, large clusters of fruit. Ripens in July.
VICTORIA RED (R) - S.F., (Seeds) Medium red fruit, strong grower, general purpose grape for eating, wine, juice, or jelly. Ripens in July.
NOTES: (R) Means resistant to Pierce's Disease

BLACKBERRIES

BABY CAKES "R" - S.F., (Thornless) Large sweet fruit on a compact bush. Grows to 3 - 4 ft.. Ideal for pots or raised beds. Ripens in July.
BIG DADDY - S.F., (Thornless) Extra large black fruit with a rich, sweet - tart flavor. Vigorous growth with high yields. Ripens June - July.
BRAZOS - S.F., (Thorns) Large high quality black fruit, heavy producer, upright growth habit. Ripens in June - July.
KIOWA - S.F., (Thorns) Extra large black fruit, very good producer, high quality sweet berries. Ripens in July.
NATCHEZ - S.F., (Thornless) Extra large black fruit on erect canes, heavy producer, great flavor. Ripens in June.
PRIME-ARK FREEDOM - S.F., (Thornless) Extra large black fruit on erect canes, heavy producer, excellent flavor. Ripens in July.
SNOWBANK - S.F., (Thorns) Large white fruiting blackberry with a sweet flavor, vigorous trailing canes. Ripens in late July.

RASPBERRIES

ANNE - S.F., Large yellow firm fruit, slight apricot flavor. Ripens in June - July and again in Sept.
BABA RED - S.F., Extra large red fruit, sweet and firm berries with excellent flavor. Ripens in June - July.
CAROLINE - S.F., Extra large red fruit with exceptional flavor, large yields throughout the summer. Ripens July - September.
DORMAN RED - S.F., Large bright red fruit, good heat tolerance. Ripens early June.
FALL GOLD - S.F., Large yellow firm fruit, sweet and juicy flavor. Ripens in July - Sept.
HERITAGE RED - S.F., Large red firm fruit, excellent berry quality. Ripens July - Sept.
RASPBERRY SHORTCAKE - S.F., Large red fruit on a compact thornless bush. Grows to 2 - 3 ft. Perfect for containers. Ripens June - July.

BLUEBERRIES

EMERALD - S.F., 200 Hours, produces large to extra dark blue fruit with a balanced sweet flavor. Ripens early - late spring.
MISTY - S.F., 200 Hours, Medium to large sky blue fruit, excellent quality. Ripens mid spring - early summer.
O'NEAL - S.F., 200 Hours, Large firm fruit, very sweet flavor, good heat tolerance. Ripens early spring - late spring.
PEACH SORBET - S.F., 300 Hours, compact plant at 1 1/2 to 2ft tall. Nice flavorful berries in summer. Colorful foliage. Ripens mid summer.
PINK LEMONADE - S.F., 200 Hours, Medium bright pink fruit with a sweet mild flavor. Ripens mid spring - late spring.
SUNSHINE BLUE - S.F., 150 Hours, Medium to large sweet fruit, compact grower. Ripens mid spring - early summer.
TIFBLUE - S.F., 550 Hours, Large light blue fruit, great flavor. Ripens late spring - early summer.

GOJI BERRY (Wolfberry)

GOJI BERRY - S.F., Small oblong red fruit, high in vitamins, produces in summer, semi-evergreen bush.

GRAPEFRUITS & PUMMELOS

GRAPEFRUIT RIO RED - S.F., Large fruit with reddish tinge on the yellow skin, deep red flesh, excellent juicy flavor, few seeds.
PUMMELO CHANDLER RED - S.F., Extra large juicy fruit with a sweet & tasty flavor. Easily segmented for eating. Seedless.

LEMONS

IMPROVED MEYERS - S.F., Medium fruit with thin yellow skin and dark yellow flesh, very juicy, semi seedy.
LISBON - S.F., Medium fruit with a juicy tart fruit, great lemon flavor. Used for juicing and zest, has few seeds.
VARIEGATED EUREKA - S.F., Medium tart fruit with yellow and green stripes, very juicy pink flesh, semi seedy.

LIMES

BEARS (Persian lime) - S.F., Large lime with excellent flavor, compact growth habit, good for growing in pots, seedless.
KAFFIR (Makrut lime) - S.F., Rough skin fruit with bitter lime flavor, very fragrant leaves used for cooking, seedless.
MEXICAN (Key lime) - S.F., Popular small lime with great flavor, very heavy producer, great for home owner, few seeds.

ORANGES

CALAMONDIN (Philippine Lime) - S.F., Small tart fruit, great lime substitute, compact bush growth, hardy to low 20's, seedless.
CARA CARA (Red Navel) - S.F., Medium size fruit with sweet red to orange flesh, has few seeds.
HAMLIN - S.F., Medium size fruit with pale orange skin and sweet flavor. Used for fresh eating or for juice, few seeds.
MORO BLOOD ORANGE - S.F., Medium size fruit with delicious red to orange sweet flesh, has a fruity flavor, few seeds.
VALENCIA - S.F., Medium to large sweet fruit, very juicy, great for making orange juice, few seeds.
WASHINGTON NAVEL - S.F., Large sweet fruit with fairly thick skin, rich orange flavor, moderately juicy, seedless.

SATSUMAS

ARCTIC FROST - S.F., Medium very sweet fruit, easy to peel, cold hardy to mid teens, thorny. Ripens in Oct. - Nov.
BUMPER - S.F., Medium sweet seedless fruit, easy to peel, heavier producer, cold hardy to low 20's, Ripens in Oct - Nov.
MIHO - S.F., Medium sweet seedless fruit, easy to peel, cold hardy to low 20's, Ripens in Oct. - Nov..
ORANGE FROST - S.F., Medium very sweet fruit, easy to peel, cold hardy to low 20's, Ripens in Oct. - Nov.
OWARI - S.F., Medium sweet seedless fruit, easy to peel, spreading growth, cold hardy to low 20's, Ripens in Nov. - Dec.
SETO - S.F., Medium size flat seedless sweet fruit, easy to peel, cold hardy to low 20's, Ripens in Oct. - Nov.

TANGERINES

ALGERIAN (Clementine) - S.F., Small reddish orange skin fruit, very sweet flavor, cold hardy to low 20's. Ripens in Nov. - Feb.

LOQUATS

GOLDEN NUGGET - S.F., Large yellowish-orange fruit with sweet orange flesh. Very heavy producer. Ripens in May - June.
SEEDLING - S.F., Small yellowish-orange fruit with sweet orange flesh. Great for landscaping as a tree or shrub. Ripens in May - June.

QUINCE

PINEAPPLE QUINCE - S.F., 100 hours, Large yellow fruit, white flesh with pineapple flavor. Ripens Sept.

HOPS

CASCADE - S.F., Most popular hop for craft brewing, spicy grapefruit floral aroma, also used for bittering.
CENTENNIAL - S.F., Has a popular unique lemon floral aroma, also used for bittering craft brew.

OLIVE

ARBEQUINA - S.F., Nickel size fruit, fast producer with bumper crops of olives. Great cold tolerance down to low 20's.

AVOCADOS

FANTASTIC - Type A, Medium green thin skin fruit with a creamy avocado flavor. Cold hardy to low 20's with age. Ripens in Sept.
JOEY - Type B, Medium black thin skin fruit with a nice avocado flavor. Cold hardy to mid 20's with age. Ripens in Sept.
LILA - Type A, Medium green thin skin fruit with a rich avocado flavor. Cold hardy to low 20's with age. Ripens in Sept.
MEXICOLA GRANDE - Type A, Medium black skin fruit with creamy, nutty flavor. Cold hardy to low 20's with age. Ripens in Sept.
PANCHO - Type B, Medium green thin skin fruit with buttery smooth flavor. Cold hardy to low 20's with age. Ripens in Sept.
NOTES - (xxx Hours) - Amount of chill hours to produce flowers for fruiting. S.F. - Self fertile / N.F. - Needs a pollinator Pg. (3)

BANANAS

BLUE JAVA (ICE CREAM) - S.F., Edible, medium yellow fruit, very popular due to its vanilla ice cream flavored fruit.
CHINESE DWARF FLOWERING - S.F., Ornamental, large sterile yellow flowers that can last for months, excellent flower shows.
DWARF CAVENDISH - S.F., Edible, medium yellow fruit, slightly shorter grocery store quality fruit with sweet flavor.
DWARF DOUBLE MAHOI - S.F., Edible, medium yellow fruit, produces two heads of fruit at the same time, sweet quality flavor.
GOLDFINGER - S.F., Edible, medium yellow fruit with sweet apple flavor. Resistant to blackleaf streak disease
GRAN NAIN - S.F., Edible, large yellow fruit, heavy producer, common grocery store variety, excellent quality fruit.
RED ABYSSINIAN - S.F., Ornamental, vibrant green and red leaves, great for landscaping or as a houseplant.
SIAM RUBY - S.F., Ornamental, red leaves with green variegation and red trunks, great for landscaping or as a houseplant.
THAI BLACK - S.F., Ornamental, green leaves with black veins and black trunks, great for landscaping or as a houseplant.
TRULY TINY - S.F., Edible, tiny yellow fruit, dwarf compact variety great for landscaping or as a houseplant.
ZEBRINA ROJO - S.F., Ornamental, bright green leaves with red stripes, great for landscaping or as a houseplant.

BRAZILIAN GRAPE TREE JABOTICABA - S.F., Small white flowers on trunk, small dark purple fruit, tart skin and sweet white flesh.

COTTON CANDY TREE (MUNTINGIA CALABURA)

COTTON CANDY TREE RED - S.F., Small red fruit with cotton candy hazelnut flavor, fast growing tree.

COTTON CANDY TREE YELLOW - S.F., Small yellow fruit with cotton candy hazelnut flavor, fast growing tree.

DRAGON FRUITS

AMERICAN BEAUTY - S.F., Small light red fruit with dark pink flesh. Blooms white flowers.
DAVID BOWIE - S.F., Small red fruit with white flesh. Blooms white flowers.
EDGAR BABY - N.F., Small red fruit with reddish-magenta flesh. Blooms white flowers.
HALLEYS COMET - S.F., Large red fruit with magenta flesh. Blooms white flowers.
PURPLE HAZE - S.F., Large red fruit with purplish-magenta flesh. Blooms white flowers.
VIETNAMESE JAINA - S.F., Medium red fruit with white flesh. Blooms white flowers.
YELLOW - S.F., Small yellow fruit with white flesh. Blooms white flowers.
ZAMORANO - S.F., Small red fruit with dark red flesh. Blooms white flowers.

GUAVAS

BARBIE PINK - S.F., Fragrant flowers, yellowish green skin, juicy & crisp pink flesh with a sweet-tart flavor.
RUBY SUPREME - S.F., Medium to large green fruit with sweet pink flesh.
TAIWANESE WHITE - S.F., Medium green fruit with sweet white flesh.

LYCHEES

BREWSTER - S.F., Small pinkish red fruit, sweet white flesh, produces excellent quality fruit.
MAURITIUS - S.F., Small pinkish red fruit, sweet white flesh, heavy producer.
SWEETHEART - S.F., Small pinkish red fruit, sweet white flesh, known for having small chicken tongue seeds.

MANGO

DWARF CARRIE - S.F., Medium yellowish-green fruit with fiberless orange flesh. Compact growth and disease resistant.
DWARF COGSHALL - S.F., Large yellow fruit with crimson blush, fiberless yellow flesh. Compact growth and disease resistant.
DWARF MALLIKA - S.F., Medium green to yellow fruit with fiberless citrus tasting flesh. Compact growth and disease resistant.

MIRACLE FRUIT (SYNSEPALUM DULCIFICUM)

MIRACLE FRUIT - S.F., Small red fruit with sweet tangy flavor, makes sour foods taste sweet.

PAPAYA

DWARF RED LADY - S.F., Compact grower, medium to large orangish red fruit with orange flesh.

FRUIT BEARING PASSION VINES

GIANT GRANADILLA - N.F., Extra large greenish-yellow fruit with yellowish-white flesh. Blooms red and purple flowers.
PANAMA RED - S.F., Large, burgundy to red skin fruit with a sweet - tangy yellow flesh. Blooms white and purple flowers.
POSSUM PURPLE - S.F., Large purple fruit with yellow flesh, sweet and slightly acidic flavor. Blooms white and purple flowers.

PINEAPPLES

SUGARLOAF - S.F., Edible, large yellow fruit with edible core, very sweet with low acidity.

SOURSOP (ANNONA MURICATA)

SOURSOP - S.F., Large green spiny fruit with white flesh, very juicy and slightly acidic flavor.

SUGAR APPLE (ANNONA SQUAMOSA)

GREEN SUGAR APPLE - S.F., Medium, green artichoke shaped fruit with white flesh, sweet custard like flavor.

TAMARIND (TAMARINDUS INDICA)

TAMARIND - S.F., Small brown pods with brown flesh, sweet and sour pulp.

CINNAMON (Cinnamomum zeylanicum)

CINNAMON - Grows up to 10ft. Inner bark used to make cinnamon spice. Twigs, leaves and berries are used to make cinnamon oil.

COFFEE TREE (Coffea arabica)

COFFEE TREE - Grown as a houseplant or patio plant. Seeds are used to make coffee. The leaves and fruit can be used for tea.

CAMELLIA TEA TREE

CAMELLIA SINENSIS - Leaves are used in making tea. Prefers rich acidic soil, shade in the afternoon. Cold hardy to mid 20's.

HIBISCUS

RED ROSELLE - Flower buds and young leaves used in make tea. Morning sun, afternoon shade. Needs some cold protection.

(These tropical plants will need cold protection during the winter. Most of these tropical fruiting plants do well in containers and can be brought inside during a freeze and moved outside when temperatures are above freezing. A greenhouse or similar structure is preferred and a heat source to maintain the temperature during a hard freeze.)
